

Each circle corresponds to the internal diameter of a ring, the number in the middle of the figure is its size.

To determine your ideal size:

1. Use one of your rings (considering the ring finger you want);
2. Position the ring over the circles to determine the diameter;
3. The circle should appear on the inside of the ring;
4. If the ring is between two sizes, choose the larger one.
